

PROJECT TERRA

Opening Scene : 3 cut scene of City and the Laboratory:

(INT – Science Lab – Flora Tech Genesis Institute)

DR. Riven turns on the webcam log to shoot his experiments and daily activity for the quest to bring plants and trees back to the planet. He adjusts his sleeves and tie and glasses and sits down to record himself.

Dr. Riven: Day 1, My name is Dr. Riven, head of Project Terra Renewal at FloraTech Genesis Institute. (looks back at fellow scientist) Do I have to do this?

Dr. Palmer: Yes, you do!

Dr. Riven: All right, fine! So, my job here is to bring back plants, which went extinct from our planet a long time ago due to a process called Deforestation. I've collected some data on some plants and how they possibly might have looked like.

(walks to a table and turns on holographic display)

Dr. Riven: This was an oak tree, one of the most important trees for our ecosystem. This was a Pine tree, which was important for timber, paper production, and habitat for wildlife. This here was called a Mangrove Tree, which was an important tree that used to protect coastlines, prevent erosions, and provide habitat for marine life. Jeez, I don't know how our planet is still alive. Thanks to some brilliant scientists.

Dr. Riven: Now let me show you what our planet was like a long time ago.

(holographic display of green and vegetation pops up on the table)

Dr. Riven: Here's what I aim to restore, but only if people treat them with respect this time. If this experiment of resurgence of plants and trees goes wrong, our planet might not survive again. We need to remember our mistakes and do what is best for us and the planet. We can rebuild our world, one tree at a time!

(Dr. Riven switches off the camera)

The screen fades to black, with a message flashing about Deforestation.
